Singer-Songwriter Heidi Swan to Perform at Butte's Broadway Café March 13, 2009

(Bozeman, MT) – Soulful singer-songwriter Heidi Swan will be performing at the Broadway Café in Butte, MT, Friday, March 13, 2009, at 7:00 pm. Swan is a Montana native, whose performances have rocked crowds across the Pacific Northwest, and the March 13 performance is her return to the Montana performing circuit.

Swan punctuated the success of her debut album *Plain Words* by touring with her six-piece band, playing the major clubs and festivals throughout Montana, Nevada, Utah, and Washington, including a performance at the 2002 Winter Olympics at the Winter Dome in Salt Lake City, Utah. Swan's new stage set highlights her new single *As Real as it Gets* from her new album *Take It All*, as well as hits such as *An Emotion*, *Her Rain*, and *Every Now and Then*. "I'm very excited to be coming back to the Broadway Café to showcase my new music," says Swan. "*Take it All* is a blend of R&B, Rock, and Pop, and I can't wait to share it with everyone who's supported me—and introduce new music lovers to my songs," she continues.

Heidi Swan grew up in Montana, playing music since the age of 8, and recently returned from the Singer-Songwriter Circuit in Los Angeles, playing such clubs as the Viper Room, the Derby, and the Hotel Café. While on this circuit she was also the featured artist with The Comedy Slams & Jams Tour with K. Michael Moore Productions featuring HBO, Comedy Central, Showtime and Mad TV comics. She headlined at the Two Big Nights Out Winter Festival in downtown Everett, Washington, was the closing act for the famed Mukiltio Lighthouse Festival along with Seattle's own Swamp Mama Johnson. Her single *Every Now And Then* was chosen as a top track on Oasis' Compilation Disc release, which is sent out annually to national college radio stations. Swan's new single *As Real as It Gets* received a 2008 Honorable Mention in the Independent Singer-Songwriter Association's annual contest (issa-music.org). Additionally, Swan received a Song of the Year award for her song *Take It All (dance remix)*, from the Song of the Year contest, which supports VH1's Save the Music Foundation (www.songoftheyear.com).
